ALL ABOUT THE PROGRAMS

Junior Toddlers and Senior Toddlers Drop In (RONSON)

The focus of this program is on toddlers and their development. Parents/caregivers play with their toddlers, exploring crafts, sensory activities, toys, pretend play, circle activities and more in our beautiful playroom. (*Juniors – 12-24 months / Seniors 2 – 3 ½ years*)

Baby's World Drop In (RONSON)

The focus for this program is on infants and their early development. Infants and parents/caregivers participate in activities such as circle. Information, workshops, support and resources are available. (*Birth to 12 months*)

Run and Jump Drop In (ISLINGTON VILLAGE)

This program focuses on gross motor skills. Children will play with balls, obstacle courses and activities that will help children with coordination. (*Birth-6 yrs*)

Sensory Discovery Drop In (RONSON)

A 4 week program for parent and child. Activities provided in the sensory play area will provide the means for your child to sharpen his/her ability to observe the differences and similarities in what he/she sees, hears, feels, tastes and smells.

Explore with Science** (RONSON)

****Pre-Registered Program.** Parents/caregivers and children learn about science together through experiments and various science related activities. The Explore with Science program creates amazing experiences that encourage discovery through play, asking questions, exploration and using creativity to solve simple problems.

Leadership Group **(HIGHFIELD)

**** Pre-Registered.** A number of sessions developed to support community members with employment search, public speaking, interview preparation, and provide them information on both the Education and City of Toronto systems.

Learn and Play Drop In, Family Time Drop In (RONSON, HIGHFIELD, ISLINGTON VILLAGE, SCARLETT MANOR)

These programs provide a time for parents/caregivers and children to meet others and to play interactively in an early learning environment. Activities include crafts, sensory, blocks, music, reading and much more. It is also a great time to get resources, information and to receive support with referrals. (*Birth-6 yrs*)

Dads and Kids (RONSON)

Dads and kids spend Saturday mornings playing and learning together; enjoying games, activities, circle time, free play and breakfast. (*Birth-6 yrs*)

Steps to Success** (HIGHFIELD)

****Pre-Registered Program.** This is a parent and child social play group that responds to your family's parenting and child development needs. Specialized professionals from the community are invited to give parents practical child development information and everyday parenting strategies to support the healthy development of your child. This program is collaboration between EarlyON and the Preschool Speech and Language Program at the George Hull Centre.

Kindergarten Readiness and Over a Cup of Tea ** (HIGHFIELD)

****Pre-Registered Program.** Kindergarten Readiness offers a stimulating, nurturing and creative learning environment for children that helps them be better prepared and able to adjust to starting kindergarten. Over a Cup of Tea is a parent discussion group that focuses on child development and parenting topics of interest to participants. Parents of children attending the Kindergarten Readiness program must participate in Over a Cup of Tea.

Together with Friends **(HIGHFIELD)

**** Pre-Registered.** A program designed to help children understand emotions and the impact of their emotions on their friends and their own bodies. Caregivers will have a new understanding of how to "read" their child's feelings and the impact on their child's behavior.

Special Guests

Why won't my baby sleep? Is my son talking as much as he should? My child is a picky eater. I am worried that my child seems so anxious all the time. What can I do to get my daughter ready to start school?

Do you have questions about your child's health, development or behavior? Every month our drop-in programs feature special visits from other professionals; sometimes a social worker, a public health nurse, a speech language pathologist or an early literacy specialist.
